DRYING TIME



Recoatable in 20 minutes. Recommended application and drying temperature is between 5-25°C. Low temperature and high humidity extend drying time of individual layers. Resinous wood also takes longer to dry on application. Wood moisture content should not exceed 20%.

TRANSPORTATION & STORAGE

To avoid the risk of spillage, always store and transport in a secure upright position. STORE AWAY FROM HEAT AND FLAME.

PREPARATION

Before applying Johnstone's Trade Woodworks Danish Oil ensure that all timber to be treated is sound, dry and free from dust, grease or any other surface contaminates. Treat any mould or lichen with a fungicidal wash as directed and protect exterior wood with Johnstone's Trade All Purpose Preserver. Use White Spirit to remove any natural oils or resins and allow to dry. Avoid inhalation of dust. Wear a suitable face mask if dry sanding. Special precautions should be taken during surface preparation of pre-1960's paint surfaces over wood and metal as they may contain harmful lead. APPLICATION



Stir Johnstone's Trade Woodworks Danish Oil thoroughly before use. Apply with brush. After 20 minutes remove any excess oil with a lint free cloth following the natural woodgrain. The surface should be uniform smooth and show no oily stains. When dry apply second coat. To ensure the aesthetic appearance and protection of the wood, maintain the substrate at least once a year. For best results maintain the wood twice a year i.e. in the Spring and in Autumn to prepare the wood for Winter.

CLEANING



Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Clean equipment immediately after use in White Spirit or Turpentine Substitute. Replace lid firmly. Application cloths and cleaning rags impregnated with product may spontaneously combust. Dispose of safely to avoid fire risks. Saturate all soiled cloths with water and place outside for disposal. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.
